## Government's Net Revenue Collection: The First 4 Months of Fiscal Year 2019 (October 2018 - January 2019)

Mr. Lavaron Sangsnit, Director-General of the Fiscal Policy Office and Spokesperson of the Ministry of Finance, stated that the government's net revenue collection in the first 4 months of fiscal year 2019 (October 2018 – January 2019), was 809,249 million baht, which was 68,416 million baht or 9.2% higher than the same period of last year. Revenue collection from Revenue Department, remittances from State-owned enterprises and revenue collection from Excise Department, were 47,916, 20,755 and 14,458 million baht or 9.4%, 41.0% and 8.5% higher than the same period of last year.

When compared to MOF's estimation, which is for monitoring and evaluating the current situation of the government's net revenue collection by considering economic situation and all the variables that affect the government's revenue collection, in the first 4 months of fiscal year 2019, net revenue collection was 17,813 million baht or 2.3% higher than estimated. Revenue collection from all departments were higher than MOF's estimation except revenue collection from Customs Department which was slightly lower than the estimation but still higher than revenue target by 3,533 million Baht or 10.2%.
